



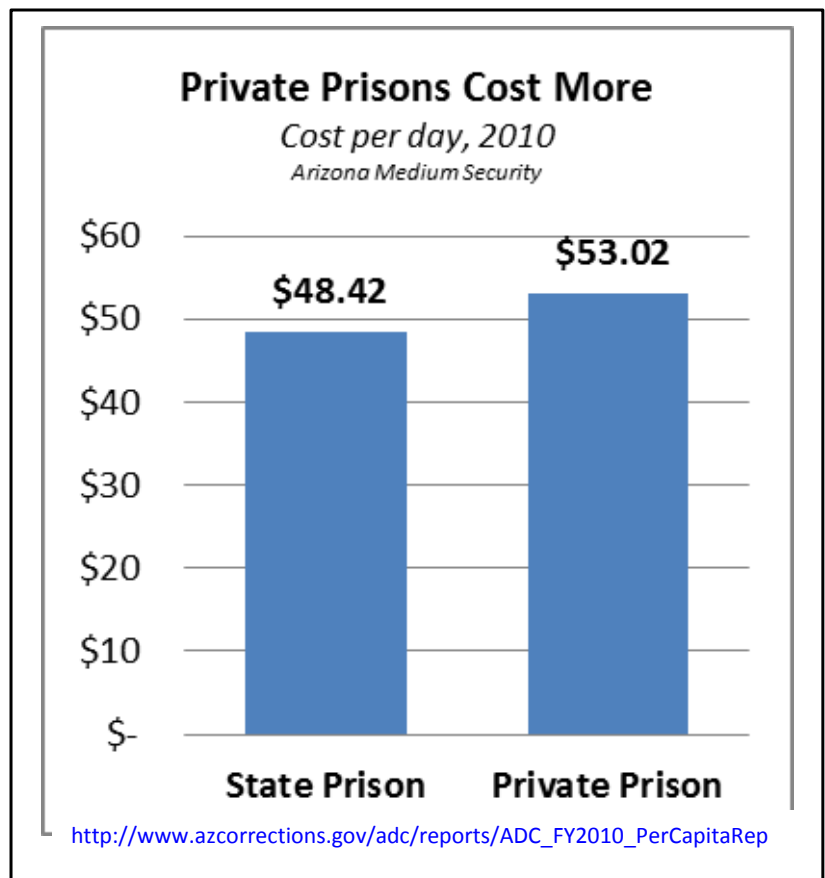
## Outsourcing NH's Prisons – A Bad Idea!

### Private Prisons Don't Save Money

The evidence simply does not support claims that private prisons are more cost-effective or efficient than publicly operated facilities.

Arizona's internal review found private medium security prisons cost \$53.02 per day, compared to \$48.42 in public prisons, a loss of more than \$1,600 per prisoner per year.

In Ohio, the law requires that private prison save at least five percent – or it's not worth the trouble and risk. During four years studied, the savings came in at 4.7%, 3.6%, and 1.3%, with one year showing private prisons were more expensive by 3.5%.
